SECTION 4 First aid measures

4.1. Description of necessary first-aid measures

First-aid measures general	: First aider: Pay attention to self-protection. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Give artificial respiration if necessary. Induce artificial respiration with mask fitted with one-way valve or other suitable device; not mouth-to-mouth. If you feel unwell, seek medical advice.
First-aid measures after inhalation	: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Lay in a stable manner on victim's side. If experiencing respiratory symptoms: Call a poison center or a doctor.

First-aid measures after eye contact	: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.
First-aid measures after ingestion	: Rinse mouth. Do not induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs, the head should be kept low so that vomit does not enter the lungs. Call a poison center/doctor/physician if you feel unwell.

Dispose of collected material as soon as possible in accordance with applicable local/regional/national/international regulations.
